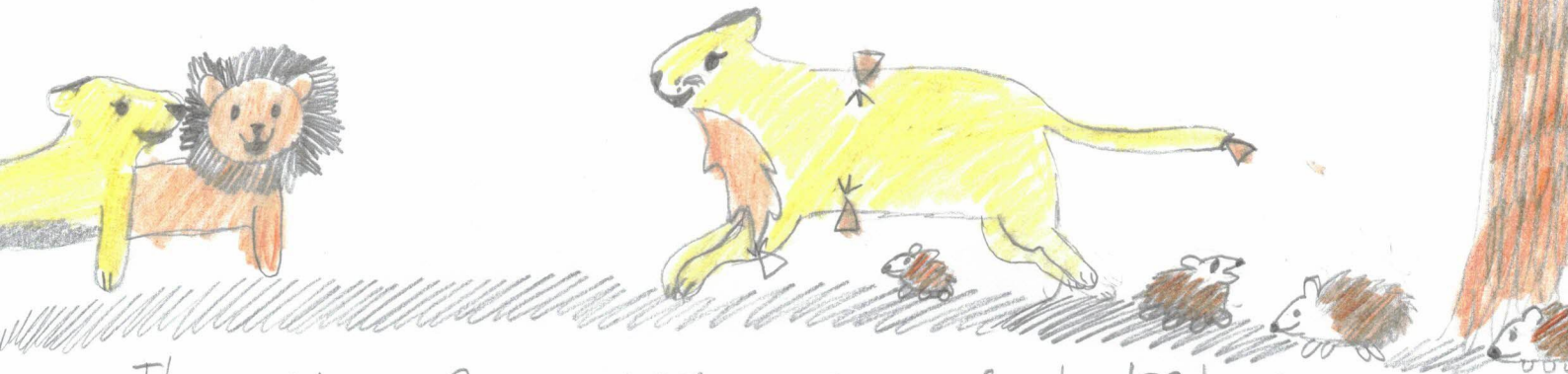
Futher north she ecountered some skunks
